Capturing Kids’ Hearts

What is our social contract?

Capturing Kids’ Heart utilizes social contracts in each classroom. A social contract is an agreement of behavior. Together, our teachers and students complete a social contract (and update it throughout the year) based on the following key questions.

*How do you want to be treated by me (the teacher)?

*How do you want to be treated by each other?

*How do you think I (the teacher) want to be treated by you?

*How do you want to treat each other when there is conflict?
