

New for 2015

- STAAR Grades 3-8 Mathematics, STAAR A, and STAAR Alternate 2 (all grades and subjects) are excluded from the 2014-15 TAPR
- 2014 STAAR Data —Only STAAR Data for 2015 is shown because a direct comparison of 2015 to 2014 is not possible due to the exclusion of STAAR A and STAAR Alternate 2
- Special Education Determination Status The 2015-16 special education integrated intervention state/determination status is provided for each district on the cover page.
- Student Success Initiative (SSI) Results are shown based on STAAR, STAAR A, and STAAR L at the Phasein I Level II standard. No ELL Progress measure students are included.


New for 2015 continued...

- Grades 5 and 8 Phase-in Satisfactory Rates Cumulative passing rates for the first two administrations of STAAR are shown for reading. No SSI results are shown for Mathematics.
- CTE Coherent Sequence Graduates Line added to include the percentage of CTE Coherent Sequence graduates for the class of 2014.
- College and Career Ready Graduates Line added to include the percentage of graduates from the class of 2014 who met the criteria for demonstrating college and career readiness.
- All Subjects All Subjects added to STAAR Percent Met or Exceeded and STAAR Percent Exceeded Progress.





2015 STAAR 3-8 Reading Performance Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above




2015 STAAR End-of-Course: English Language Arts Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above




2015 STAAR 3-8 Mathematics Performance Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above


2015 STAAR End-of-Course: Mathematics Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above




2015 STAAR 3-8 Science Performance Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above




2015 STAAR End-of-Course: Biology Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above




2015 STAAR 3-8 Social Studies Performance Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above




2015 STAAR End-of-Course: U.S. History Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above




2015 STAAR 3-8 Writing Performance Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above


STAAR Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above All Grades, Reading




STAAR Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above All Grades, Mathematics




STAAR Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above All Grades, Writing






STAAR Percent at Phase-in Satisfactory Standard or Above All Grades, Social Studies




STAAR Percent Met or Exceeded Progress All Grades, Reading




STAAR Percent Met or Exceeded Progress All Grades, Mathematics




STAAR Percent Exceeded Progress All Grades, Reading




2015 Attendance 2013-2014 School Year




2015 Annual Dropout Rate (Grades 7-8)




2015 Annual Dropout Rate (Grades 9-12)




4-Year Longitudinal Graduation Rate (Grades 9-12) Class of 2014 Cohort



4-Year Federal Graduation Rate Without Exclusions (9-12) Class of 2014 Cohort




5-Year Extended Federal Graduation Rate Without Exclusions (9-12) Class of 2013 Cohort








Class of 2014 College Ready Graduates Both Subjects




Average SAT Score, All Subjects



Average ACT Score, All Subjects




2014 Student Ethnic Distribution






