

Henderson County Arts Council Scholarship Procedure

The Scholarship process will be headed up by the Vice President.

A screening/selection committee chaired by the Vice President and two (2) Council members will review all applications and make a final recommendation to the Board.

Students attending a High School in Henderson County ISD may apply.

Students must be attending or planning to attend an accredited College/University and majoring in one of the Arts.

The Counselor at each school will be provided information on the scholarship. Unless someone other than the Counselor is designated by the school, the Counselor will ensure students know the scholarship is available to apply for and be the focal point for the student.

Applications packages must be submitted, in full, no later than March 30 of that year. No exceptions will be granted.

The selection process by the Scholarship Committee will be completed by April 15 of that year.

The selected student(s) will be presented a check made payable to the College/University they plan to attend. That check will be deposited into the student's account and may be used for tuition, books, supplies.

If the student for any reason does not attend College/University, the check will be returned to the Henderson County Arts Council.

Or, if the student drops out of the school, any unused money in the account will be returned to the Henderson County Arts Council. This will be included in instruction to the College/University with the check.
